As part of its philanthropic community outreach, EQT is funding the ASSET science program in Greene County elementary schools.

Schools participating in this program include: Carmichaels Area Elementary School in the Carmichaels Area School District; Jefferson Morgan Elementary School in the Jefferson-Morgan School District; Bobtown Elementary School in the Southeastern Greene School District and Springhill-Freeport and Graysville Elementary Schools in the Greene School District.

Now in full implementation, **78 participating teachers** are receiving ASSET's Institutes for Inquiry and Assessment as well as professional development on over 11 science modules. Through EQT's commitment to the Greene County region, more than **1,900 students** are experiencing ASSET's hands-on, inquiry-based approach to learning that will spark their interest and fuel their learning, preparing them to think-critically, discover and innovate for success now and in future STEM related careers.
